Award Management, Banner Finance and Research Accounting Roles

Prime award, Sub-Award; Subcontractors

- A. Prime Awardee: Where Lehigh works directly with one of these entities, Lehigh is referred to as the Prime recipient of an award.
- B. **Subawardee or Pass-thru**: Where Lehigh deals indirectly with one of these entities and this other entity is the Prime recipient of an award, Lehigh is referred to as the Subrecipient of the award. This award is set up in Banner where Lehigh is referred to as the Pass-Thru recipient of this award. The Prime Agency in these awards is typically another University or an external organization or laboratory.
- C. **Subcontractor**: Lehigh may have an entity that performs work under there award or subaward. This other entity is referred to as a subcontractor to Lehigh's award. This subcontract activity and Budget is recorded in Banner Account codes 78001-78007 and payment is requested by subcontractor via invoice to ORSP. Beginning in FY18, Research Accounting will implement procedures to encumber subcontracts to provide the PI with more reliable information on a Grants available budget balance.

Invoice Processing procedures:

- 1. ORSP/Research Accounting Coordinator receives an invoice from a Subcontractor.
- 2. The ORSP/Research Accounting Coordinator verifies the Fund has available budgeted funds in Subcontractor Budget account code 78001-78007
 - If there are no available funds and/or there is no subcontractor budget, then the invoice is sent to the ORSP CGS to resolve with the PI if necessary.
- 3. The ORSP/Research Accounting coordinator scans and sends the PI via email the invoice and the invoice template checklist to complete.
- 4. The ORSP/Research Accounting coordinator prepares a payment approval and attaches the invoice and approval email.
- 5. The ORSP/Research Accounting coordinator obtains additional approval from the CGS in ORSP and keeps copy in file.
- 6. The ORSP/Research Accounting coordinator submits the paperwork to Accounts Payable Department for processing

System for Award Management (SAM)

The System for Award Management (SAM) combines federal procurement systems and the Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance into one new system. The Director of Office of Research and the Manager of Research Accounting have access to SAM with a User ID and User Password. Annually, the Manager of Research Accounting updates and renews Lehigh University's status on SAM.

Grants Online:

Lehigh uses Grants Online for the administration of grants awarded by the Department of Commerce (A Division through of the Department of the Treasury). National Institute of Standards and Technology is a Division of the U.S. Department of Commerce.

Grants Online is designed to automatically retrieve and distribute proposals from Grants.gov, the government-wide portal for the receipt of applications. It is an electronic grants processing and administration system. Thus, the people who interact with the system to do their jobs will enter data. These people are Request for Application (RFA) creators, Federal Program Officers, Procurement Request Authorizing Officials, Line Office Reviewers, Grants Specialists, Grants Officers, and others. Program Officers can avoid doing additional data entry by requiring applicants to submit proposals through Grants.gov. Additionally, Grantees will input data for Financial and Progress reports as well as for Award Action Requests as needed. Grants.gov is only able to accept PDF, Word, Excel, and text files.

Grants.gov is used to find and apply for funding opportunities. Grants Online does not replace any of the functionality in the Treasury Department's ASAP system. You will still need to access ASAP to drawdown your grant funds. However, submission of SF-270 forms requesting non-ASAP payments can and should be made via Grants Online. Since there is no system-to-system interface between Grants Online and ASAP, if an extension is made to a NOAA award, the Grants Online workflow will send a task to the appropriate NOAA staff to extend the award in ASAP also. The award extension in ASAP is an action that happens outside of the Grants Online system.

eRA Commons:

Lehigh uses eRA Commons for the administration of grants awarded through HHS and HRSA. HRSA grants are awarded to organizations for the purpose of improving and expanding health care services for underserved people.

eRA Commons is an online interface where grant applicants, grantees and federal staff at NIH and grantor agencies can access and share administrative information relating to research grants.

eRA Commons users, based on their role, can conduct a variety of business in Commons, including:

- 1. Track the status of their grant applications through the submission process, view errors and/or warnings and check the assembled grant image.
- 2. View <u>summary statement</u> and <u>score</u> letters following the initial review of their applications.
- 3. View notice of award and other key documents.
- 4. Submit Just-in-Time information (SO only) requested by the grantor agency prior to a final award decision.
- 5. Submit the required documentation, including the Financial Status Report/Federal Financial Report and final progress report, to close out the grant.
- 6. Submit a No-Cost Extension notification (SO only) that the grantee has exercised its one-time authority to extend without funds the final budget period of a project period of a grant.
- 7. Submit an annual progress report electronically using the Research Performance Progress Report (RPPR).
